ENGR. ROLANDO T. BACANI of the National Transmission Corporation (TRANSCO) is hereby appointed as Chairman of the GMC. Furthermore, the terms of office of all initial members of the GMC shall commence on January 1, 2003.

The aforementioned appointees shall convene within one (1) month from the date hereof. The GMC shall submit, for approval of the ERC, the rules and procedures relating to the conduct of its business within two (2) months from the date they convene thereof.


The nominations for the membership of Small Generators, Private and Local Government Distributors, and of Suppliers in the GMC shall be re-opened for nomination upon publication of this Notice in a newspaper of nationwide circulation. The said nominations shall conform with the guidelines on the nomination and selection process as provided for under the "Guidelines to Govern the Formation of the Grid Management Committee", dated May 15, 2002. Nominees for Regular Membership must possess all of the following qualifications:

- a) Good moral character with no criminal conviction;
- b) A Licensed Electrical Engineer;
- c) Five (5) years experience in a position involving management and/or supervision of an electric utility or in services related to the electric power industry to equip him with sufficient technical knowledge to fully understand and evaluate the technical aspects of Grid operation, planning, and development; and,
- d) Member of a bona fide association with activities related to the specific sector he is to represent in the GMC, if applicable.

All concerned sectors are directed to submit in writing their respective nominees within one (1) month after this notice is published, including the nominee's Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae, Statement of Vision, and NBI Clearance.


The terms of office of those to be appointed as representatives for Small Generators, Private and Local Government Distributors, and of Suppliers in the GMC shall also commence on January 1, 2003;
