ORDER

On 27 November 2015, Camiguin Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CAMELCO) filed an amended application for the approval of its unplanned capital expenditure projects: a) installation of the previous new 5 MVA substation to 10 MVA substation; b) acquisition of logistics for maintenance of 69 kV subtransmission line (from Balingasag to Esperanza, Kinoguitan, Misamis Oriental); and c) acquisition of right-of-way, and approval of loan application with the

National Electrification Administration (NEA) or other financial institutions, with prayer for provisional authority.

On 11 April 2016, the Commission issued an Order and a Notice of Public Hearing setting the amended application for jurisdictional hearing, expository presentation, pre-trial conference and evidentiary hearing on 2 June 2016.


On 6 May 2016, CAMELCO filed an "Urgent Motion to Transfer Hearing Scheduled on 2 June 2016" praying that the scheduled hearing set on 2 June 2016 be cancelled and the requested resetting of the case be re-scheduled to 9 June 2016 at 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon because there is a conflict of schedule of the officers who will be active participants during the hearing as well as the members of the Board of Directors.

Finding the said motion meritorious, the same is hereby **GRANTED**. Accordingly, the Commission hereby sets the amended application for jurisdictional hearing, expository presentation, pre-trial conference and evidentiary hearing on **9 June 2016 (Thursday) at two o'clock in the afternoon (2:00 P.M.) at the CAMELCO Main Office, Mambajao, Camiguin.**

CAMELCO is hereby directed anew to cause the publication of the attached Notice of Public Hearing, at its own expense, twice (2x) for two (2) successive weeks in two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines, with the date of the last publication to be made not later than ten (10) days before the date of the scheduled initial hearing. It is also directed to inform the consumers within its franchise area, by any other means available and appropriate, of the filing of the instant application, its reasons therefor, and of the scheduled hearing thereon.

Let copies of this Order, and the attached Notice of Public Hearing be furnished the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), the Commission on Audit (COA), and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress. They are hereby requested, if they so desire, to send their duly authorized representatives at the scheduled hearing.

Likewise, let copies of this Order and the attached Notice of Public Hearing be furnished the Offices of the Provincial Governor of Camiguin and Mayors of the Municipalities within the franchise area of CAMELCO for the appropriate posting thereof on their respective bulletin boards.



CAMELCO is hereby directed to furnish all those making requests therefor with copies of the application and its attachments, subject to reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs.


On the date of the initial hearing and pre-trial conference, CAMELCO must submit to the Commission its written Compliance with the jurisdictional requirements attaching therewith, methodically arranged and duly marked, the evidences on the actual posting and publication of the Notice of Public Hearing consisting of certifications issued to that effect, signed by the afore-mentioned Governors and Mayors or their duly authorized representatives, bearing the seals of their offices, and the affidavit of the Editor or Business Manager of the newspaper where said Notice of Public Hearing was published together with the complete issue of the said newspaper, and such other proofs of compliance with the requirements of the Commission.

CAMELCO and all interested parties are directed to submit, at least five (5) days before the date of initial hearing and pre-trial conference, their respective Pre-Trial Briefs containing, among others:

- (a) A summary of admitted facts and proposed stipulation of facts;
- (b) The issues to be tried or resolved;
- (c) The documents or exhibits to be presented, stating the purposes thereof and proposed markings therefor; and
- (d) The number and names of the witnesses, with their written testimonies in an individual affidavit form, to be attached to the Pre-Trial Brief.

Failure of CAMELCO to submit the required Pre-Trial Brief and Judicial Affidavits of its witnesses within the prescribed period shall be a ground for cancellation of the scheduled hearing, and the resetting of which shall be six (6) months from said date of cancellation.

As part of the pre-trial conference, CAMELCO must also be prepared to make an expository presentation of its application, aided by whatever communication medium that it may deem appropriate for



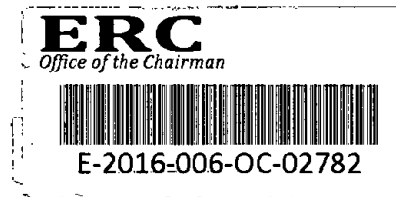
the purpose, in order to put in plain words and explain, for the benefit of the consumers and other concerned parties, what the application is all about and the reasons and justifications being cited in support thereof.
