**ORDER**

On 26 April 2021, Camotes Island Power Generation Corporation (CAMPCOR) filed an *Application* seeking the Commission's approval of its authority to develop and own or operate dedicated point-to-point limited transmission facilities to connect its 6.984 MW Heavy Fuel Oil (HFO) Fired-Diesel Power Plant to the Camotes Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s (CELCO) 13.8 kV distribution system (Camotes Main Grid), with prayer for the issuance for provisional authority or interim relief.

On 07 May 2021, the Commission issued an *Order* and *Notice of Virtual Hearing*, both dated 03 May 2021, setting the instant

*Application* for the determination of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements, expository presentation, Pre-trial Conference and presentation of evidence on the following dates:

02 July 2021	Determination of Jurisdictional Compliance and Expository Presentation
09 July 2021	Pre-trial Conference and Presentation of Evidence

However, the Commission notes that it has inadvertently scheduled a hearing on 02 July 2021 which is the anniversary of the City of Pasig. To avoid the cancellation of the 02 July 2021 hearing and the unnecessary cost for republication due to the impending declaration of the Office of the President of the said date as a special non-working holiday in the City of Pasig, the Commission finds it in order to cancel the hearing on 02 July 2021 and set it on another date.

**IN VIEW OF THE FOREGOING**, the Commission hereby sets another hearing for determination of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements, expository presentation, Pre-trial Conference and presentation of evidence on the following dates and online platform for the conduct thereof pursuant to Resolution No. 09, Series of 2020<sup>1</sup> dated 24 September 2020:

**RELATIVE THERETO**, CAMPCOR is hereby directed to:

- 1) Cause the publication of the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* once (1x) in a newspaper of nationwide circulation in the Philippines at its own expense, with the date of

publication to be made not later than ten (10) days before the date of the scheduled initial hearing;

- 2) Furnish with copies of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* the Offices of the Provincial Governor, the Mayors and the Local Government Unit (LGU) legislative bodies within the affected areas for the appropriate posting thereof on their respective bulletin boards;
- 3) Inform the consumers within the affected areas of the filing of the *Application*, its reasons therefor, and of the scheduled hearings thereon, by any other means available and appropriate;
- 4) Furnish with copies of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing*, the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), the Commission on Audit (COA), and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress. They are hereby requested, if they so desire to send their duly authorized representatives and attend the scheduled hearing; and
- 5) Furnish with copies of the *Application* and its attachments all those making requests therefor, subject to the resolution of the prayer for confidential treatment of information, if any, and reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs.<sup>2</sup>

Within five (5) calendar days prior to the date of the initial virtual hearing, CAMPCOR must submit to the Commission via electronic mail (e-mail) at [docket@erc.ph](mailto:docket@erc.ph), copy furnish the Legal Service through [legal@erc.ph](mailto:legal@erc.ph), the scanned copies of its written compliance with the aforementioned jurisdictional requirements attaching therewith, methodically arranged and duly marked, the following:

- 1) The evidence of publication of the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* consisting of affidavit of the Editor or Business Manager of the newspaper where the said *Notice of Virtual Hearing* was published, and the complete issue of the said newspaper;

- 2) The evidence of actual posting of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* consisting of certifications issued to that effect, signed by the aforementioned Governor, Mayors and LGU legislative bodies or their duly authorized representatives, bearing the seals of their offices;
- 3) The evidence of other means employed by CAMPCOR to inform the consumers within the affected area of the filing of the *Application*, its reasons therefor, and of the scheduled hearing thereon;
- 4) The evidence of receipt of copies of this *Order* and the attached *Notice of Virtual Hearing* by the OSG, the COA, and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress;
- 5) The evidence of receipt of copies of the *Application* and its attachments by all those making requests therefor, if any; and
- 6) Such other proof of compliance with the requirements of the Commission.

Moreover, CAMPCOR is hereby required to post on its bulletin boards, the scanned copies of the foregoing jurisdictional requirements, together with the newspaper publication and certifications issued by the concerned Office of the Mayors, Governor and Local Legislative Bodies, and to submit proof of its posting thereof.

CAMPCOR and all interested parties are also required to submit via e-mail at [doCKET@erc.ph](mailto:doCKET@erc.ph), copy furnish the Legal Service through [legal@erc.ph](mailto:legal@erc.ph), at least five (5) calendar days before the date of the scheduled virtual hearing and Pre-trial Conference, their respective Pre-Trial Briefs containing, among others:

- 1) A summary of admitted facts and proposed stipulation of facts;
- 2) The issues to be tried or resolved;
- 3) The documents or exhibits to be presented, stating the purposes and proposed markings therefor, which should also be attached to the Pre-trial Brief; and

- 4) The number and names of the witnesses, with their written testimonies in a Judicial Affidavit form attached to the Pre-trial Brief.

CAMPCOR must ensure that all the documents or exhibits proposed to be presented have already been duly submitted to the Commission at least five (5) calendar days before the date of the scheduled initial virtual hearing and Pre-trial Conference pursuant to the preceding paragraph.

Failure of CAMPCOR to comply with the above requirements within the prescribed period shall be a ground for cancellation of the scheduled hearing, and the resetting of which shall be six (6) months from the said date of cancellation.

CAMPCOR must also be prepared to make an expository presentation of the instant *Application*, aided by whatever communication medium that it may deem appropriate for the purpose, in order to put in plain words and explain, for the benefit of the consumers and other concerned parties, the nature of the *Application* with relevant information and pertinent details substantiating the reasons and justifications being cited in support thereof.

CAMPCOR is hereby directed to file a copy of its Expository Presentation via e-mail at [doCKET@erc.ph](mailto:doCKET@erc.ph), copy furnish the Legal Service through [legal@erc.ph](mailto:legal@erc.ph), at least five (5) calendar days prior to the scheduled virtual hearing. CAMPCOR shall also be required, upon the request of any stakeholder, to provide an advance copy of its expository presentation, at least five (5) calendar days prior to the scheduled virtual hearing.

Any interested stakeholder may submit its comments and/or clarifications at least one (1) calendar day prior to the scheduled virtual hearing, via e-mail at [doCKET@erc.ph](mailto:doCKET@erc.ph), copy furnish the Legal Service through [legal@erc.ph](mailto:legal@erc.ph). The Commission shall give priority to the stakeholders who have duly submitted their respective comments and/or clarifications, to discuss the same and propound questions during the course of the expository presentation.

CAMPCOR is hereby directed to submit, either through personal service, registered or ordinary mail/private courier, one (1) set of the original or certified true hard/printed copy/ies of its Jurisdictional Compliance, Expository Presentation, Pre-trial Brief, and Judicial

Affidavit/s of witness/es, within five (5) working days from the date that the same were electronically submitted, as reflected in the acknowledgment receipt e-mail sent by the Commission. Similarly, all interested parties who filed their Petition for Intervention or Opposition are required to submit the hard/printed copy thereof within the same period through any of the available modes of service.


