**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:**

Notice is hereby given that on 28 December 2016, Mactan Electric Company, Inc. (MECO) filed an *Application* dated 20 December 2016 for the renewal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

MECO alleged the following in its *Application*:

1. MECO is a Filipino corporation duly organized and existing under Philippine laws with principal office at MECO Building, Sangi Road, Lapu-Lapu City, Province of Cebu. It may be served with processes and papers through the undersigned counsel.
2. Republic Act No. 10890 granted MECO a franchise to construct, install, establish, operate and maintain, for commercial purposes and in the public interest, a distribution system for the conveyance of electric power to the end-users in the City of Lapu-Lapu and the Municipality of Cordova, Province of Cebu. MECO's franchise is effective for 25 years from the effectivity date of RA 10890 on July 17, 2016.
3. MECO hereby applies for the renewal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) pursuant to the Rules to Govern the Issuance of CPCN to Entities Engaged in the Transmission and Distribution of Electricity, as approved in ERC Resolution No. 05, Series of 2008.

5. MECO possesses all the qualifications for a CPCN: (a) it is a Filipino corporation; (b) it has a franchise; and (c) it has the technical and financial capabilities to operate the subject distribution system.

**RELIEF**

WHEREFORE, applicant MECO prays for the renewal of its CPCN for a term coterminous with its franchise.

MECO also prays for equitable relief.

The Commission has set the *Application* for determination of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements, expository presentation, Pre-trial Conference, and presentation of evidence on **21 June 2017 (Wednesday) at two o'clock in the afternoon (2:00 P.M.) at the ERC Hearing Room, 15<sup>th</sup> Floor, Pacific Center Bldg., San Miguel Ave., Pasig City.**

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All persons who have an interest in the subject matter of the instant case may become a party by filing with the Commission a verified Petition to Intervene at least five (5) days prior to the initial hearing and subject to the requirements under Rule 9 of the 2006 Rules of Practice and Procedure, indicating therein the docket number and title of the case and stating the following:

- i. The petitioner's name and address;
- ii. The nature of petitioner's interest in the subject matter of the proceeding and the way and manner in which such interest is affected by the issues involved in the proceeding; and
- iii. A statement of the relief desired.

All other persons who may want their views known to the Commission with respect to the subject matter of the case may file their Opposition or Comment thereon at any stage of the proceeding before Applicant rests its case, subject to the requirements under Rule 9 of the 2006 Rules of Practice and Procedure. No particular form of Opposition or Comment is required, but the document, letter, or writing should contain the following:

- 1) The name and address of such person;
- 2) A concise statement of the Opposition or Comment;  
and
- 3) The grounds relied upon.

All such persons who wish to have a copy of the *Application* may request from Applicant that they be furnished with the same, prior to the date of the initial hearing. Applicant is hereby directed to furnish all those making such request with copies of the *Application* and its attachments, subject to the reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs. Any such person may likewise examine the *Application* and other pertinent records filed with the Commission during the standard office hours.
