Thank you for your usual immediate and favorable response.

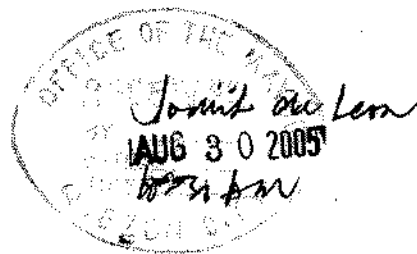
